




Industrial Exports





Industrial Exports by sector %






Exports' Geographical Distribution





Main Industrial Exports






Syrian Crisis Impact on Jordanian Exports



936 firms meets the criteria




Only 3 sub-sectors were exempted



Project including SADIRATCOM and Export Hub will be established by JCI.

Long-term result: Increase in exports and growth of Jordanian industry, attraction of foreign direct investments, decrease in unemployment and enhancement of situation of Syrian refugees.
